

FULL BODY MOUNTS EXPLAINED

A full mount (full body mount) is a type of mount which is a life size replication of the species. These mounts are made with either floor or wall bases. Wall bases are viable for small to medium sized species.

We have five standard available full mounts forms all differing in “head direction”. Head direction is determined by the direction the animal is looking. Do not be confused by the direction you look when standing in front of the animal.

1. Full mount – Hard Left: Full body mount with animal looking 90° to the left,
2. Full mount – Left: Full body mount with animal looking 45° to the left,
3. Full mount – Straight: Full body mount with animal looking straight ahead,
4. Full mount – Right: Full body mount with animal looking 45° to the right,
5. Full mount – Hard Right: Full body mount with animal looking 90° to the right,
