
SHOULDER MOUNTS EXPLAINED

A shoulder mount is a type of mount which is put up against a wall, with the back of the mount perpendicular to the centerline of the animal.

We have seven standard available shoulder mount forms all differing in "head direction". Head direction is determined by the direction the animal is looking. Do not be confused by the direction you look when standing in front of the animal.

Hard Right: About a 75° angle to the right of the centerline of the animal,
Half Right: About a 45° angle to the right of the centerline of the animal,
Quarter Right: About a 22.5° angle to the right of the centerline of the animal,
Straight: The animal is looking straight ahead along centerline of animal,
Quarter Left: About a 22.5° angle to the left of the centerline of the animal,
Half Left: About a 45° angle to the left of the centerline of the animal.
Hard Left: About a 75° angle to the left of the centerline of the animal.
