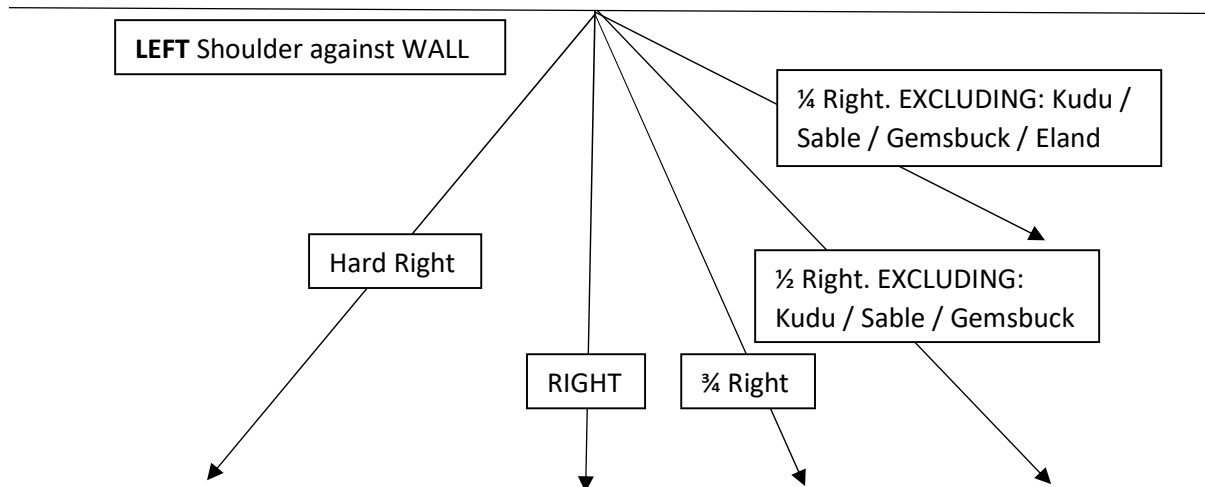


## WALL PEDESTAL MOUNTS (LEFT SHOULDER ON WALL) EXPLAINED

A wall pedestal mount is a type of mount which is put up against a wall, with either left or right shoulder against the wall and head is facing away from the wall, into the room.

We have four standard available wall pedestal mount forms all differing in “head direction”. Head direction is determined by the direction the animal is looking. Do not be confused by the direction you look when standing in front of the animal.

1. Quarter Right: Left shoulder on wall, looking 22.5° away from wall, into the room  
NO Kudu, Sable, Gemsbuck, Eland
2. Half Right: Left shoulder on wall, looking 45° away from wall, into the room,  
NO Kudu, Sable, Gemsbuck
3. Three-Quarter Right: Left shoulder on wall, looking 67.5° away from wall, into the room,
4. Right: Left shoulder on wall, looking 90° away from wall, into the room,
5. Hard Right: Left shoulder on wall, looking 135° away from wall, into the room,

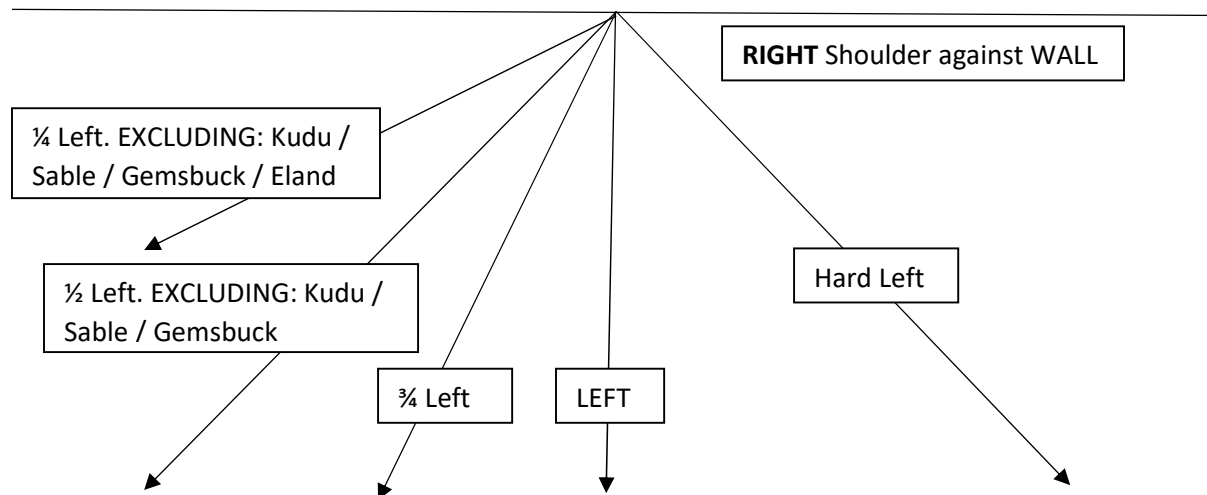

3. Three-Quarter Left: Right shoulder on wall, looking 67.5° away from wall, into the room,
4. Left: Right shoulder on wall, looking 90° away from wall, into the room,
5. Hard Left: Right shoulder on wall, looking 135° away from wall, into the room,
